

PENINSULA CRIME LINE, INC.

Since 1982, the Peninsula Crime Line, has been successfully fighting crime on the Peninsula through its partnership with the community, law enforcement and the media. The Peninsula Crime Line, Inc.'s goal is to make our neighborhoods and businesses safer places to live and work by seeking information from the public that solves crimes. Private businesses, organizations and citizens donate money to pay rewards. The media helps generate public awareness of unsolved crimes.

ANONYMITY

Peninsula Crime Line, Inc. callers use the number 1-888-LOCK-U-UP to give anonymous tips. Law enforcement's Crime Line coordinator forwards this information to an investigator for action. If an arrest is made, stolen property recovered, or illegal drugs seized based on the callers' information, the caller is eligible for a cash reward up to \$1,000. Callers are not required to leave their names or telephone numbers and they are not required to testify in court. Callers are given confidential numbers which are used to track progress of the tip and callers use to collect the cash reward.

SUCCESS

With the community's support the Peninsula Crime Line, Inc. has successfully been enabling the arrest of criminals for over 20 years. Because Crime Line's tips minimize law enforcement's investigative time, significant tax dollars are saved by reducing the number of investigative hours that normally would have been expended.
